provide a home for a homeless Apache family. Additional funds and labor arrives from an army of volunteers from across the United States year-round to meet the felt needs of families as God leads and provides.

Well over 250 children and 100 teens have seen and heard of Christ's love through our mobile ministries, distribution of back packs and school supplies and Christmas stockings and fleece blankets.



Arizona Reservation Ministries was incorporated in 2002 to provide "God's ARMs around the Reservation." In addition to the ways mentioned above, food, home furnishings and more are distributed as available. With unemployment on this reservation nearing 77%, the needs are innumerable. Relationships grow between ARM team members and Apache leaders, parents, grandparents and others. (This ministry is well-known on this Reservation of nearly 14,000 tribal members on over 2,854 square miles!) A Bible-Study continues on a weekly basis at the tribal assisted-living facility, love is shared as often as possible at the tribal-run youth home (crisis foster home), and much more!

YOUR tax-credit contribution would be a huge blessing-both to the work of Arizona Reservation Ministries and to those of the San Carlos Apache Tribe.

All contributions must be postmarked by December 31, 2008 in order to obtain the Arizona Tax Credit. (\$400 maximum for those filing jointly, \$200 for a single person filing his/her 2008 AZ tax return.)
