

Urgent Update

The text for our Winter Quarterly Newsletter is composed by mid-January. At that time, we had already experienced a "minor" flood, washing out several feet of the road between our 45 acres and the road leading us to the San Carlos Apache Reservation. Just a few weeks later, a much larger flood occurred, completely washing the road and three culverts away. The Lord had orchestrated that two of our 15-passenger vans were on the "right" side of the gulf, but our teen bus, the children's bus, still with an engine under repair, and everything else was inaccessible. The four men of our ARM team spent the better part of 6 hours in a freezing river retrieving the culverts. Countless hours were then spent installing much larger culverts, and a large amount of new dirt and rocks. A group of volunteers constructed a foot bridge so that we had partial access. Water and gas lines were all damaged. We are grateful for the prayers of many who had been made aware of this situation. We are also deeply grateful for the assistance of generous partners and IDES, who have covered approx. half of this unplanned expense.
