Mobile Ministries

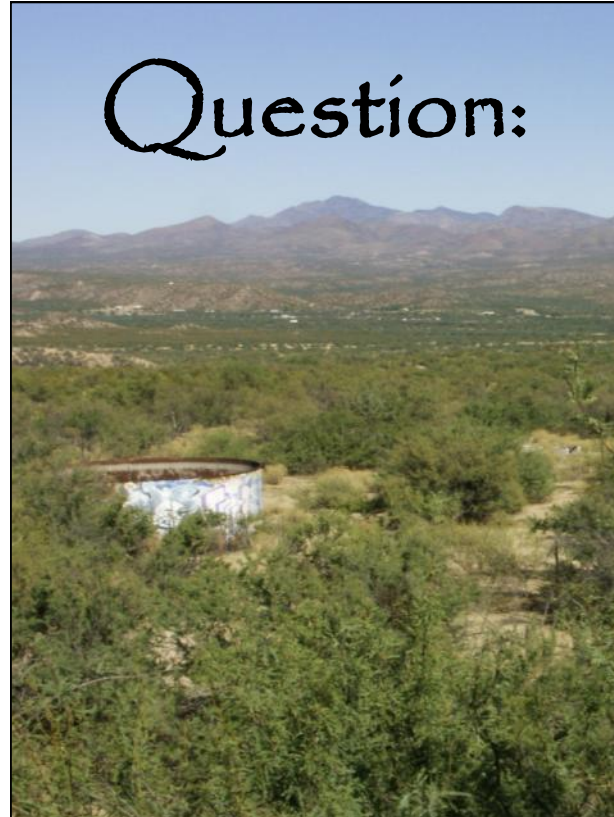
Arizona Reservation Ministries...

was established in April of 2002 to provide "God's ARMs around the reservation." A.R.M. exists to *make* disciples of the Native American People, empowering them to *meet* the physical and spiritual needs of their community, *motivating* them to become active *members* of local Bible-based churches. A.R.M. assists brothers and sisters on the reservation in many ways :

- Leading kids and teens on our mobile ministry centers to Apache churches for further discipleship.
- Families are developing relationships with A.R.M. staff—as well as the Lord—through their children and through Apache churches.
- Tribal agencies have encouraged weekly visits and Bible Studies, as those in leadership of these agencies are, themselves, committed Believers.
- Assisting Apache churches with building maintenance, presenting VBS programs and leading Sunday School classes in partnership with Apache church members.



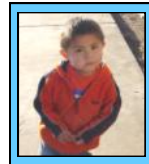

The Answer is Mobile Ministries!

Arizona Reservation Ministries visits neighborhoods on the San Carlos Apache Reservation every week through our Mobile Ministry Centers.

The Bus

The “Church Bus,” as it is affectionately called by the kids on the reservation, rolls into a neighborhood and honks the horn. Kids run from every direction to participate in Bible lessons, memory verses, singing, snacks, and small group time. The focus is Jesus Christ, with lessons these children can hang onto in their days and nights of unimaginable difficulties. After the lesson time, they all scatter to play. Some stay inside the bus playing with Mr. Potato Head, board games, etc. Others head outside for activities like jump rope, rollerblades, or even basketball with the hoop attached to the back of the bus.



Teen Bus

As attendance grew on our first mobile ministry center, we dreamt of a second bus just for those who were older. God has blessed us with that second bus, just for those sixth grade or 12 years old and above. This bus also has the seats removed. Inside you'll find a couch, game table, televisions, X-Box, PlayStation2, microwave, refrigerator, craft supplies, and more...things relevant to these young Apache adults. Recently, teen moms and their infants have begun attending, bringing great opportunities as well.
